A light-hearted and ridiculous street theatre performance for all ages, 'piece of cake' is a cake-catastrophe of epic proportions. Witness Ant and Sarah as they strap on their aprons and demonstrate just how it's done (well one of them anyway).

Combining dance, physical comedy and slapstick with various baking instruments, watch as they whip up a frenetic flurry of flour for your viewing pleasure!

Initially commissioned by Ludus Dance as a 'wise-up' micro commission, 'piece of cake' has been extended to its full glory. To date it has been lovingly performed at a number of events and festivals, including: Lancashire ENCOUNTER festival (Preston), the Hothouse (More Music in Morecambe), Lancaster First Friday's (Lancaster), the Just Be Arts Festival (Skerton) and the Burnley College Arts Festival (Burnley).

## what you get

A 20 minute interactive outdoor performance work that can be performed up to three times throughout the day (audiences are welcome to pick up a broom and help to clean up afterwards!).

Tours with two performers from the back of a car. Available for both outdoor and indoor festival environments. Best served dry, however we are in England, so light showers are ok. The piece can be performed in one location or moved to other areas of the festival or event site after each show.

## logistics

As the piece already comes with a PA system and full compliment of cooking materials, all that is required is a large space (approx. 10-15ft sq) access to a green room space to clean/change between shows and water for the final clean up.\*
